Frequently Asked Questions

Q *What is Ministry Connection?*

A Ministry Connection is an online tool that allows churches to more easily communicate its internal volunteer opportunities and/or needs to its members, as well as the opportunities and needs of local ministries with whom we have elected to partner.

Q *How does it work?*

A Members and guests may access Ministry Connection through the home page of our website. The main Ministry Connection page will provide three options: (1) Connect in My Church; (2) Connect in My Community; and (3) Connect in My World.

The 'In My Church' button will take you to a section that lists current opportunities within a variety of specific church ministries. Users may also select 'All Church Needs' to get a broader perspective of opportunities for ministry and service.

The 'In My Community' button will take you to a section that lists current ministry opportunities and/or physical needs of a number of local ministry and service organizations, such as The CALL, Bethany Christian Services, and the Salvation Army.

The 'In My World' button will take you to our 'Missions Central' page, which provides a variety of information regarding missions, ministry, and our Park Hill Baptist Church photo gallery, among other things.

Frequently Asked Questions

(Continued)

Q *How do I sign up for an opportunity or need?*

A Simply select the listing you would like to fill, and add that to your 'cart.' You may continue perusing opportunities and needs, or simply click the button that says, "I will meet the selected need." You will then be prompted to register, and your information will be directed to the contact person for that ministry or organization.

Q *What if my Family Bible Study class would like to serve together?*

A You will find that many ministries and organizations have multiple needs, many of which list a preferred quantity of volunteers. For example, you may desire to serve as Greeters at a church or community event. If that event specifies '10' as the number needed, then you may provide as many as 10 volunteers. Of course, if you only have four class members who can help at that particular time, then you may register four volunteers, knowing that others will round out the 10 needed.

Q *How do I handle calendaring a class ministry event?*

A Due to our church liability insurance, it is still necessary for the class leader or contact person to contact Kay Young in our administrative office in order for the event to be added to our master calendar and online calendar. If your class would like to take a church van, then you will need to mention that to Kay at the time your ministry event is scheduled.

It is always helpful and advisable to also contact your specific staff leader to communicate your participation in a ministry event or activity.

(Continued)

Q *What are the benefits of using Ministry Connection?*

A Several come to mind.

1. By utilizing this platform, we will be better steward of our time and resources. Rather than duplicating services as a church, we will be able to better identify and cooperate with other community ministries that are already meeting a specific need or ministering to a specific group.
2. With Ministry Connection you no longer have to ask the question, “What can I do?” or “How can I serve?” Whether in the church or in the community, you’ll have quick access to see places for you and your class to get plugged in.
3. You can opt to receive email updates when new opportunities are posted in the ministry areas you are passionate about.
4. When you sign up through Ministry Connection, you’ll receive email reminders of your commitment to serve.

Q *Do you release email addresses or other personal information to other organizations?*

A No. Your organizational and personal information is only used to connect you with the ministries of our church and/or the community agency or organization with whom you choose to serve. We do not disseminate, distribute, sell, or otherwise share you information with other organizations without your consent.
